○ Detailed Information

1. Ara Waterway: is South Korea's first eco-friendly inland waterway connecting Han River and Yellow Sea. This 18km-long waterway is built using cutting-edge technologies and creates a water-friendly cultural space to improve the quality of citizens' life. Its intelligent high-tech facilities, the latest logistics systems based on network, and green information technology also combine environment and IT industry of Korea. (Its name "Ara" comes from the most well-known Korean folk song "Arirang.")

2. Manisan (Mt. Mani): at 496.4 meters above the sea level, is the highest mountain in Ganghwa Island. It became a designated National Tourist Site in 1977. Its paths are well-paved for hiking, and once you get on the top of the mountain, you will see surrounding Gyeonggi area and West Sea. There is a historical temple called Jeongsusa from Koryo Dynasty and an alter called Chamseongdan from ancient times on Manisan.
